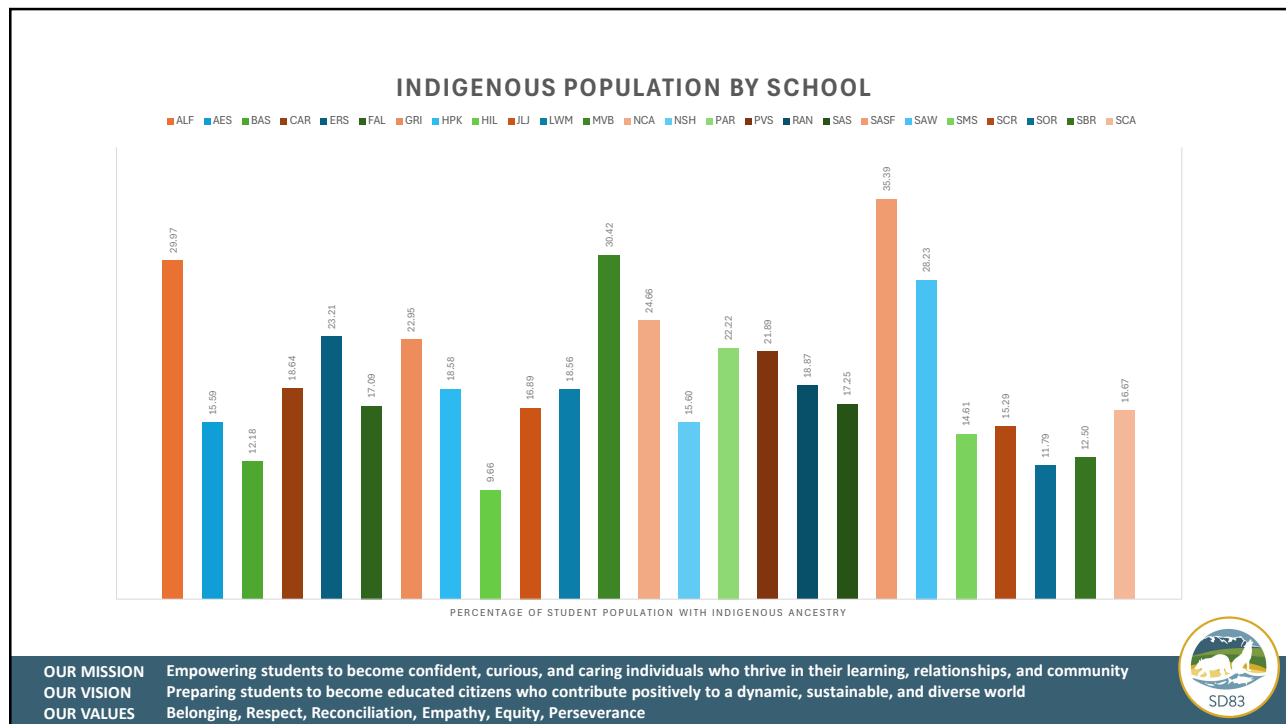
DISTRIBUTION OF INDIGENOUS STUDENTS IN THE DISTRICT



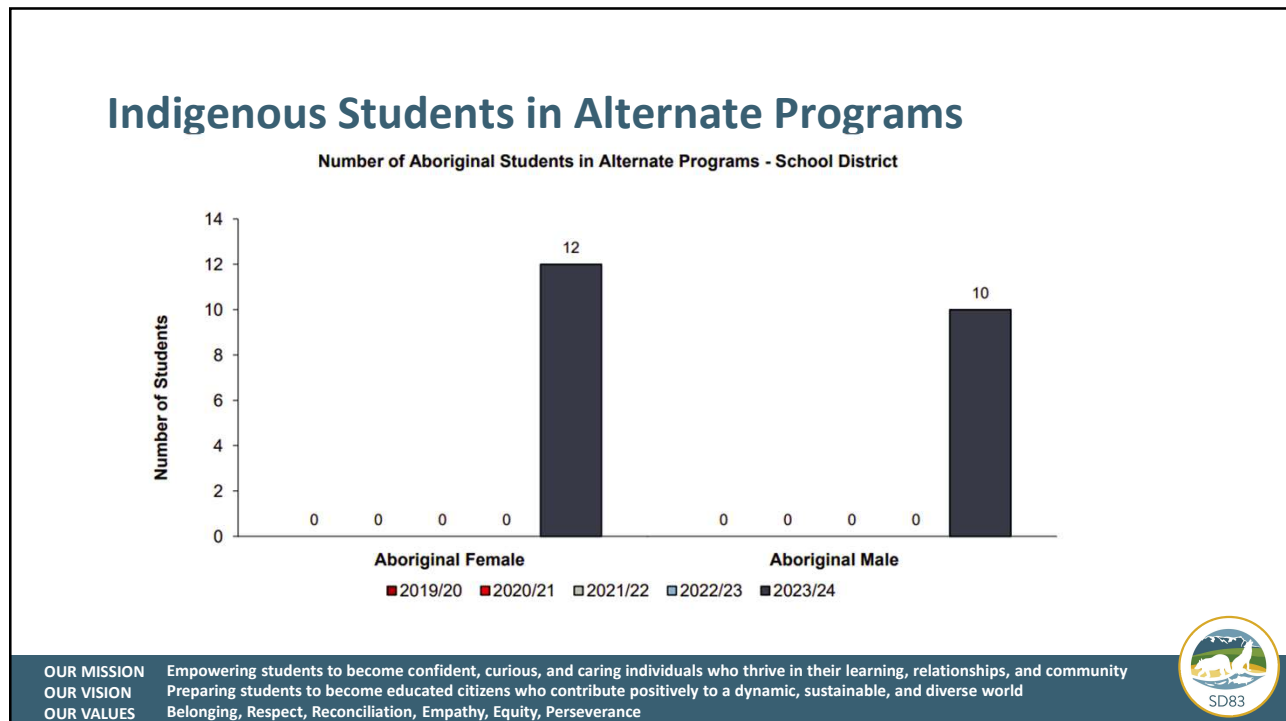
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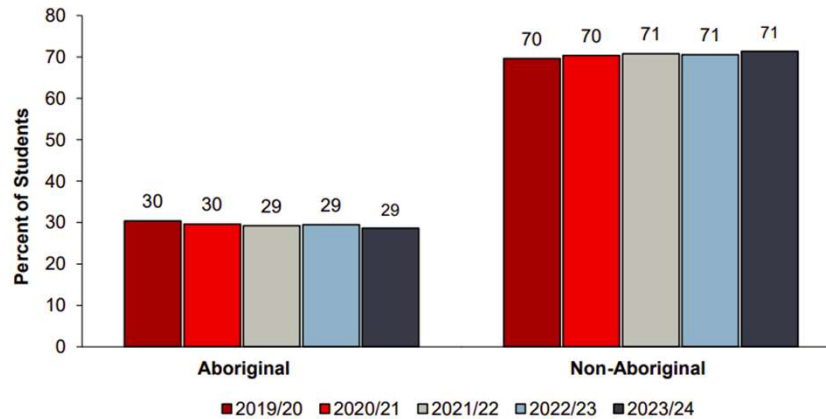

(12 Designations)



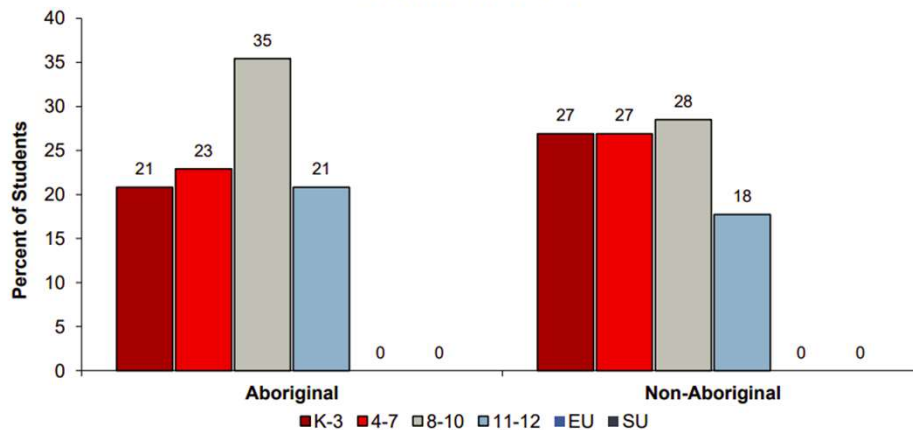

Grade Distribution 2023/24

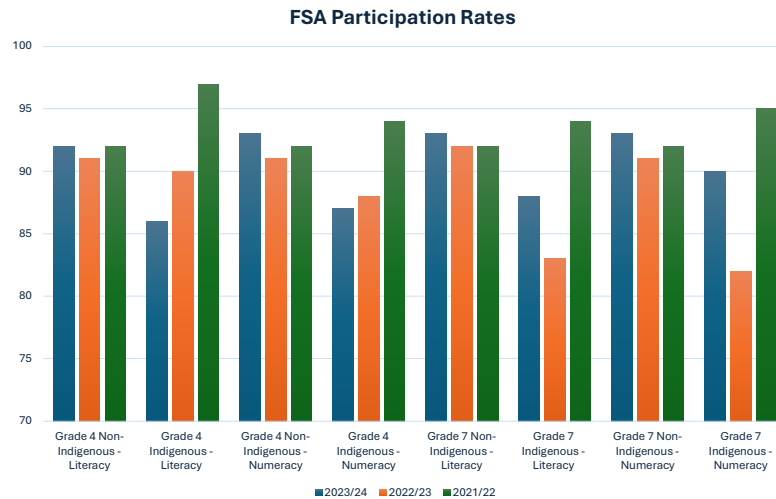


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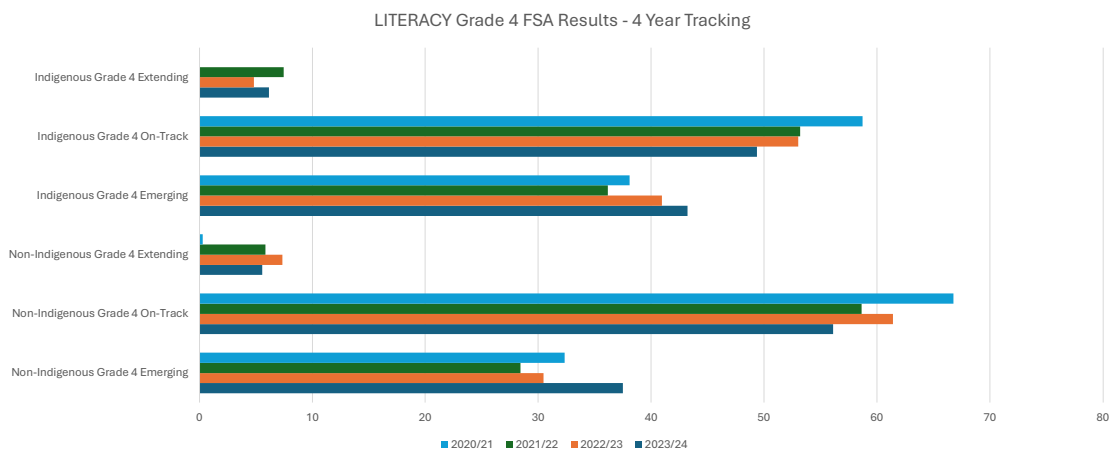

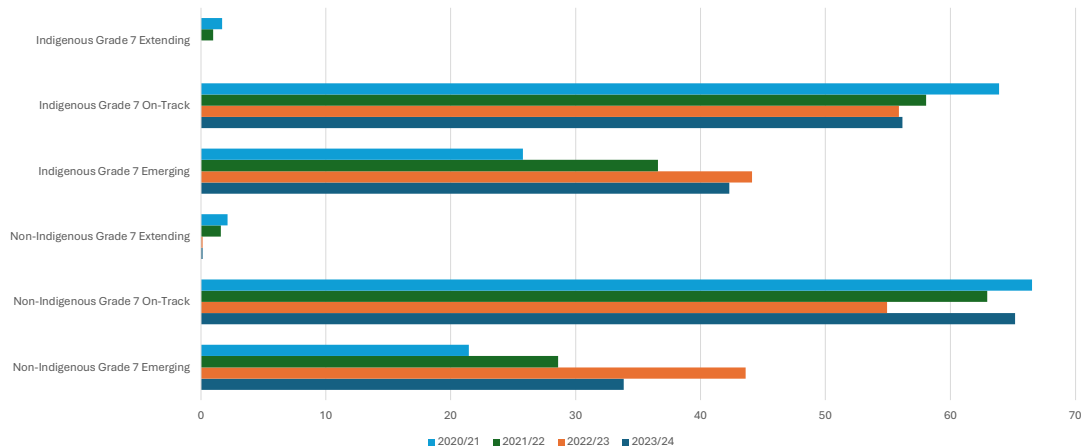

LITERACY Grade 7 FSA Results - 4 Year Tracking



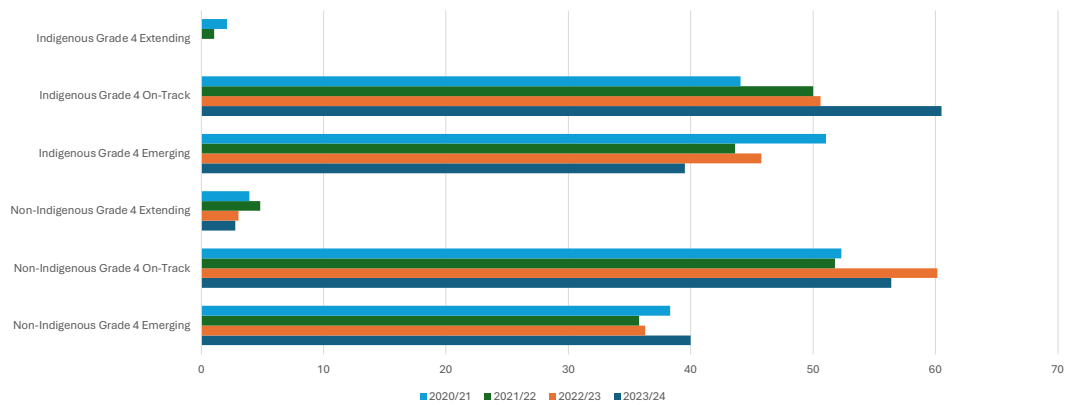

NUMERACY Grade 4 FSA Results - 4 Year Tracking

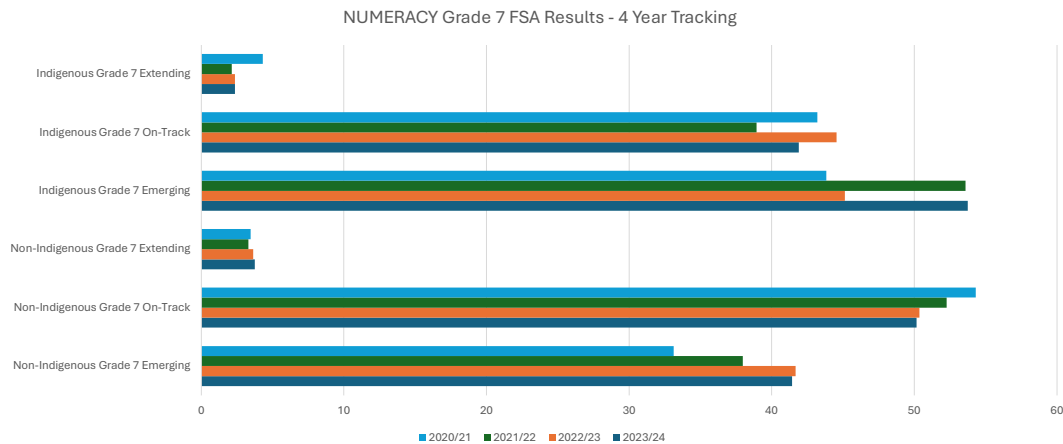

Six-Year Completion Rate

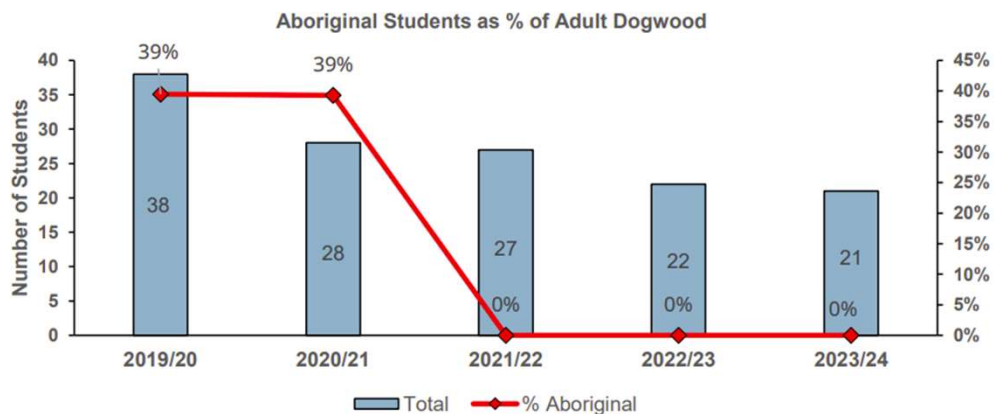
