

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 210

HOMESCHOOLING

BACKGROUND

The District recognizes the right of a parent to educate their child at home in accordance with the [School Act](#).

PROCEDURES

1. Parents who wish to educate their child at home must register the child at their catchment area school, prior to September 29 of each year.
2. Evaluation and assessment
 - 2.1. Home school parents are eligible for:
 - 2.1.1. Assessment normally provided by the District following standard procedures.
 - 2.1.2. Standardized testing and/or provincial assessment in accordance with established District and/or provincial procedures.
3. Access to Materials
 - 3.1. Home school parents are eligible for:
 - 3.1.1. Textbooks provided on loan to the student in a manner to be determined by the Principal.
 - 3.1.2. Library books provided on loan to the student in a manner consistent with District practice.
 - 3.1.3. Materials not returned or continually returned in damaged condition may result in certain privileges being denied with the exception of materials that are authorized and recommended by the Minister.
 - 3.1.4. Equipment may not be rented or loaned.
