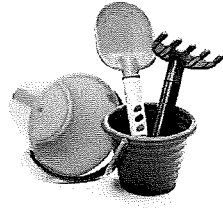


Too many toys!

Too many toys!



Susan tells April that she has 3 more toys than her. Lisa tells Susan that she has 2 more toys than her. If April has 5 toys, how many toys does Lisa have?

SOLUTION
April = 5 toys
Susan $5 + 3 = 8$ toys
Lisa $8 + 2 = 10$ toys.

Lisa has 10 toys.
