

# Provincial SIS history

- An attempt was made in 2006 to move to all School Districts to a provincial SIS called BCeSIS
- BCeSIS drew media attention in September 2010 for slow performance that hampered the efforts of schools to make timetable changes, process student transfers, and complete attendance.
- With new school districts using the service, Fujitsu Service Desk was forced to limit the number of logins and post "BCeSIS unavailable" messages during peak usage hours.
- In September, 2011, the Ministry of Education decided to discontinue the use of the BCeSIS software, based on a recommendation from Gartner, Inc.
- The Minister of the day George Abbot said that the system had glitches but was still good value for money, and was being replaced largely because the technology was outdated.


