RE: Salmon Arm School Configuration

Background

Since the board motion of November 2023 where district administration was directed to bring configuration options forward for consideration, there have been a total of 35 discussion sessions involving employee groups, school parent advisory councils, members of the public, parents/caregivers, students, and the principal/vice-principal leadership team. In addition to these face-to-face discussion sessions, the Board has received survey information from each of the forementioned groups.

<u>Issue</u>

All discussions to date have focused on revisiting the five options (E1 - E5) suggested in the 2019-2029 Long Range Facilities Plan with the addition of a sixth option which is a variation of E3 (K-7, 8-12 two secondary model) proposing a K-7, 8-12 three secondary school model.

Though there is a diversity of opinion contained within the public survey, the public face to face sessions demonstrated more alignment and agreement regarding the configuration options. The employee surveys and principal/vice-principal surveys indicate a preference to have the Board consider a K-7, 8-12 model along with the E5 option which was adopted "in principle" during the spring of 2021.

With current enrolment projections suggesting a softening of enrolment numbers, the space pressures faced in 2021 are no longer as significant. District leadership which includes principals/vice-principals and district leadership agree that a K-7, 8-12 model is the most "educationally and developmentally sound." Parents/caregivers and principals from rural Salmon Arm feeder schools have indicated that they wish to have their children/students enter secondary school with students from urban Salmon Arm schools which would align all schools with a common configuration.
