This trip will be Shuswap Middle School's eleventh Québec field trip for French Immersion students in grade 8. We have been using the service of Jumpstreet for the past few years now as they are a tour company that is smaller and has excellent rapport with clients and students. Attached is the proposed itinerary, in great detail, along with some pricing and insurance information.
