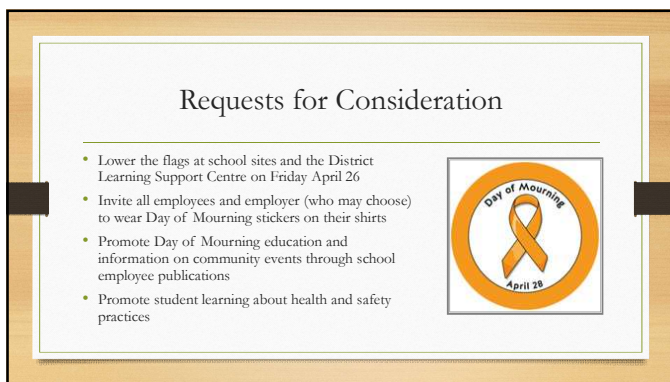

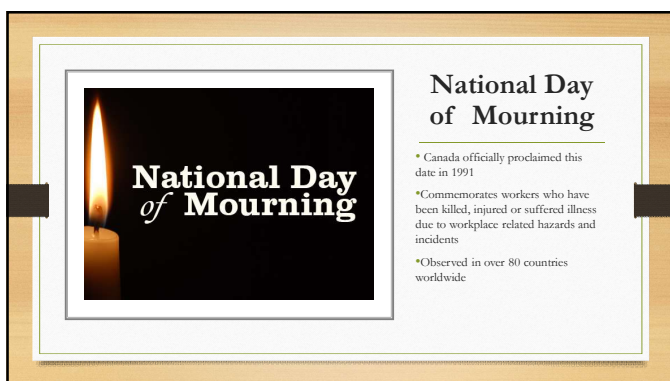

- Plan and participate in education training sessions for Site Reps
- Run TVR and injury reports, identifying patterns and trends
- Make recommendations to SLT regarding current OH&S issues
- Provide support to site committees
- Hold monthly meetings and produce minutes that are distributed district wide

### What Do JHSC do?

- Meet monthly to discuss site safety issues
- Notify staff of safety concerns and new procedures
- Conduct two site inspections a year
- Provide guidance to coworkers who are experiencing unsafe work
- Report findings to staff of recent injuries or possible safety concerns
- New site reps attend an 8 hour new committee member training session
- All reps attend one 8 hour training session

## Young Workers In BC



- Lack knowledge of dangers of work and their rights as workers
- From 2010-2014 there were 32,000 young workers injured and 29 work related deaths
- Every week, 7 young workers are permanently disabled
- Young males between the ages of 15-24 are twice as likely to get injured on the job
- The highest rate of injury occurs in the hospitality, retail and construction industry


